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Lenka focuses on issues of “conflict sensitive development” and the use of mediation and facilitation techniques in project management in transforming and/or post-conflict regions. She is a lecturer of courses: Security, Conflict and Development; Politico-geographical Processes in Developing Regions (good-governance) and Qualitative Research Methods at the Department of Development

Studies, Palacký University. She is also engaged in non-formal education of youth and conflict and multicultural trainings. Since 1997 she actively participates in the activities of the youth-led NGOs focused on promoting youth participation, tolerance, multiculturalism and development (as a youth member and later as workshop leader and facilitator). The experience also includes leading processes of organisational growth and transformation of the NGOs; and trainings and consultancy for NGOs working in transforming regions. Lenka values and emphasises active participation and use of dialogue and peer education.
