Manuel Janeira has a PhD in Sports Sciences and he is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Sports of the University of Porto. Over the past 35 years, he shared his interests in teaching (mainly subjects related to High Performance Basketball Training), scientific research, students' orientations and university governance. He supervised more than 40 Masters and PhD theses, and published more than 80 scientific papers. He is a member of the Portuguese Olympic Academy. Between 2003 and 2015, he was responsible (as a vice rector) for the sports and cultural policies of University of Porto. He also led the Portuguese Mission to Izmir (2005) and Bangkok (2007) and Summer University Games. He played basketball for more than 20 years, representing Portugal in several international basketball competitions. Furthermore, he also served as head coach at different basketball teams and at different competitive levels.
