
Saša Milenković

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Prof. Sasa Milenkovic is a professor at the Faculty of Sport and Physical Education at University of Niš; he has been working at the faculty for the past 30 years and has progressed from assistant to full professor. His main subject in Basic Academic Studies is Theory and Methods of Corrective Gymnastics (compulsory course in the fourth year of study), and Tennis (optional course in the third year).
