


How to access course syllabi in STAG (Palacký University information system)

1. Go to the home page of Palacký University information system:

https://stag.upol.cz/portal/studium/index.html?pc_lang=en

You do not need to log in to look up courses.


2. Go to *Browse IS/STAG* → *Courses*
