Niels Boysen Feddersen is an Associate Professor at the Department of Teacher Education and Outdoor Studies at the Norwegian School of Sport Science and a programme leader of the Adapted Physical Activity and Disability programme. Currently, Dr Feddersen examines the rehabilitation of neurological injuries, such as spinal cord injuries and head injuries. The primary focus here is how adapted physical activity and peer support programmes are adapted to the Norwegian healthcare system and injury demographics. Additionally, there is a focus on how users, mentors, and healthcare personnel experience rehabilitation activities. This research is conducted in collaboration with rehabilitation organizations and researchers in Norway, Sweden, Poland, Denmark, and Iceland.
